Page 1: General

Page 3: Ports and Logistics

Page 3 provides an overview of the development and utilization of ports and harbors in Japan and abroad that serve as bases for international container logistics, as well as corporate trends in the related fields of port transportation, warehousing, forwarders, and air cargo.

Page 4: International news, analysis article

In addition to the latest information on the launch of new factories abroad by major manufacturers and international logistics companies, Page 4 also includes a "Perspective from Journalists" section, which features commentary and analysis based on the exclusive reporting of journalists.

Page 5: Ocean business, regional news

Page 5 looks at projects undertaken by parties affiliated with ports and harborsto promote the industry, as well as the latest trends in marine development. It also contains an "In-depth Feature" section that takes a deep dive into the news, as well as various data on ports and customs.

Page 6: Events and Culture

Page 6 provides an overview of events planned and organized by industry associations and local port officials, essays related to the sea, and popular new books.

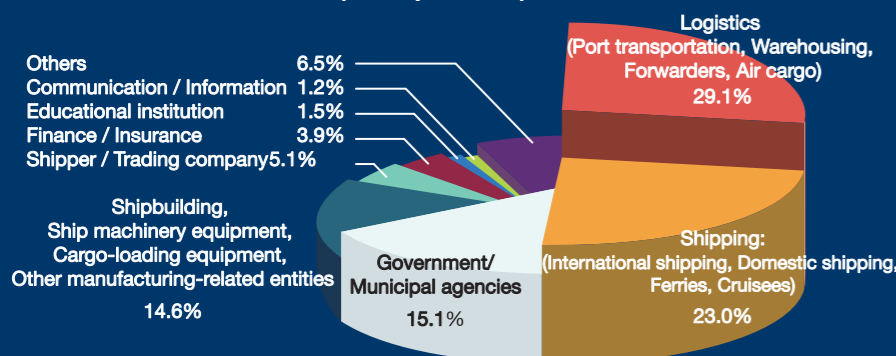

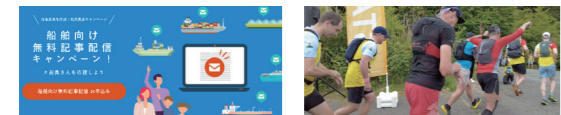

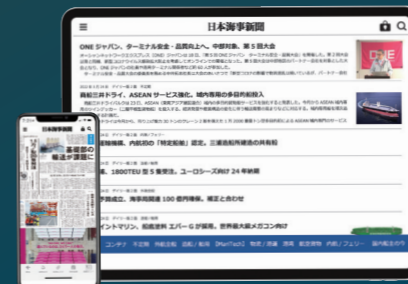
